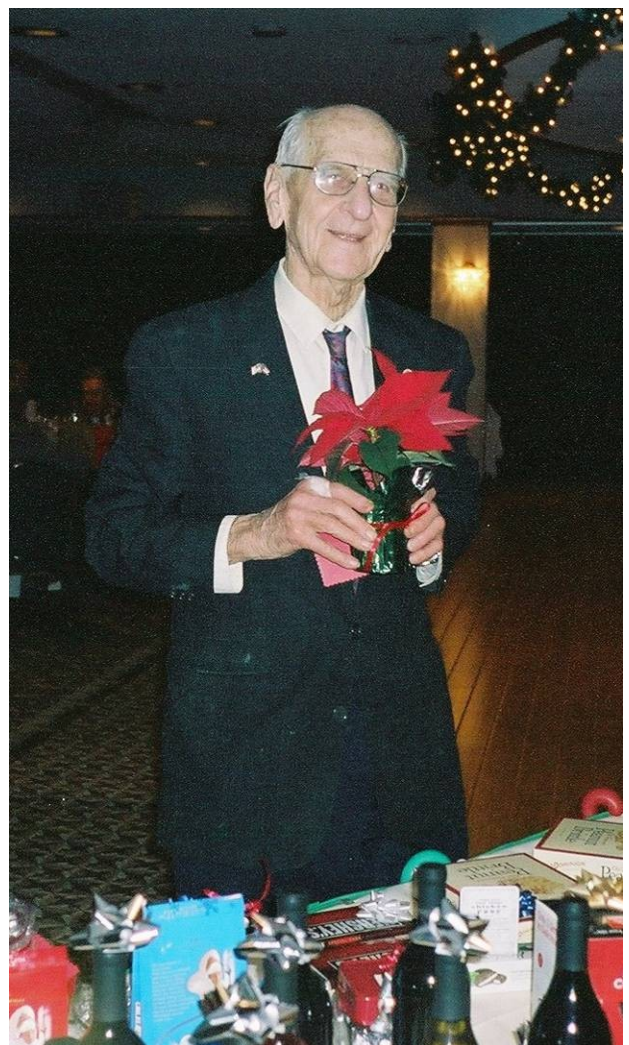
##### Previous Flight Leg [20 Dec 2011] (Standard Debrief):

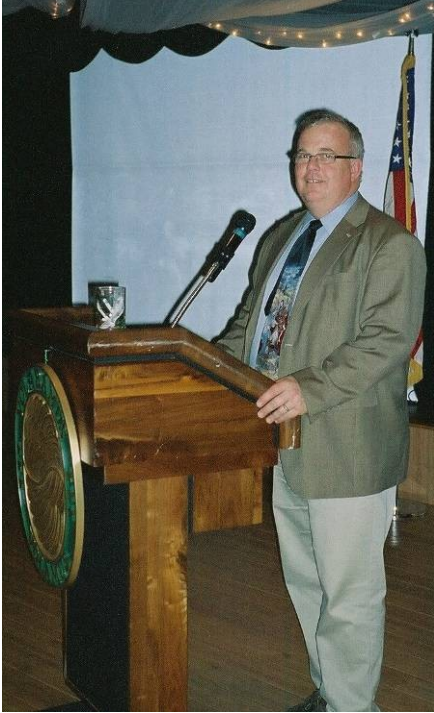

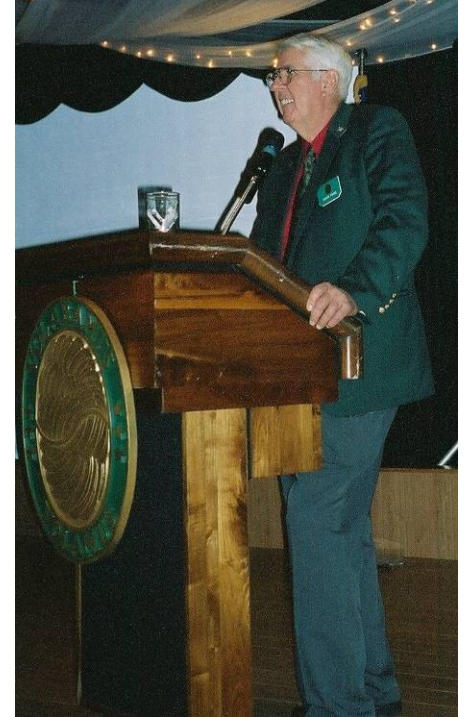

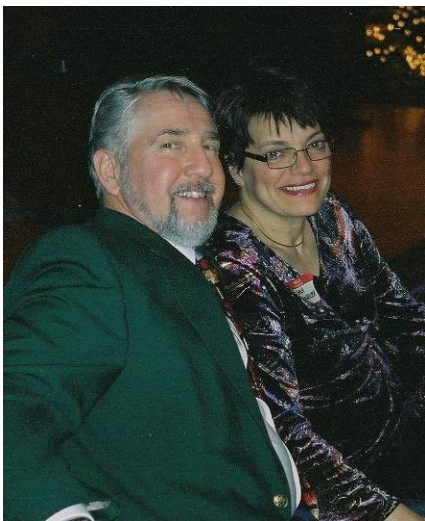
